THE APPLICATION OF MIDWEST OIL CORPORATION FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

## ADMIVISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION CONVISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Midwest Oil Corporation rade application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on Decomber 11, 1972, for permission to dually complete its New Mexico State "W" Well No. I located in Unit G of Section 3, Tourship 23 South, Range 26 East, NHTM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Carlsbad-Atoka Cap Pool and the South Carlsbad-Morrow Gas Pool.

Now, on this 8th day of January, 1973, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED: .

That the applicant homein, Midwest 011 Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its New Mexico State "W" Well No. 1 located in Unit G of Section 3, Township 23 South, Renge 26 East, NEEM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Carlsbad-Atoka Gas Pool and the South Carlsbad-Morrow Gas Pool through the casingtubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED FORTURE. That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER. That applicant shall take packer-loskage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Shut-In Pressure Test Period for the South Carlsbad-Morrov Gas Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That juricdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deca necessary.
