- 11/23/74** Pulled tubing and set bridge plug above all perforations at 9075', dumped 35 sxs cement on top of bridge plug. Perforate and squeeze 4 times as follows: 4 holes at 9040', set retainer at 8980' pumped 200 sxs cement, no fillup. Perforate 4 holes at 8920', set retainer at 8910', pump 200 sxs cement, top of cement at 8460', Perforate 4 holes at 8450', set retainer at 8420' squeeze with 75 sxs cement, final pressure 2000 psi. Perforate 4 holes at 8405', set retainer at 8350', broke circulation between 5-1/2" and 8-5/8" casing strings. Cemented with 100 sxs class "H" cement, top of cement at 8090'. Drill out cement and retainers to 8910', test to 2000 psi, ok.
- 12/9/74** Perforate Strawn with 15 holes 8409' to 8899'. Set packer at 8333' and treat perforations with 3000 gal acid and 28 ball sealers. Swab and tested well for 15 days. Well produced an estimated 25 Mcfd of gas and 10 bbls per day of formation water.
- 12/28/74** Well status shut in 725 psi tubing pressure. Adobe is waiting on partners decision to continue workover or plug and abandon well.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
