THE APPLICATION OF ADOBE OIL  
COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-2003

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Adobe Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on December 8, 1972, for permission to dually complete its Smith Federal Well No. 1 located in Unit G of Section 14, Township 23 South, Range 24 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Rock Tank-Upper Morrow Gas Pool and the Rock Tank-Lower Morrow Gas Pool.

Now, on this 21st day of December, 1972, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That waivers of objection have been received from offsetting operators and the waiting period as prescribed by said rule may be dispensed with in this instance.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Adobe Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Smith Federal Well No. 1 located in Unit G of Section 14, Township 23 South, Range 24 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Rock Tank-Upper Morrow Gas Pool and the Rock Tank-Lower Morrow Gas Pool through the casing-tubing annulus respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Shut-in Pressure Test Period for the Rock Tank-Lower Morrow Gas Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
