

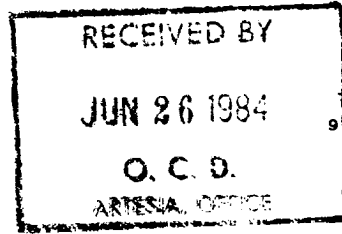

Due to the excessive water production and low producing pressures associated with the O'Neill Federal No. 1 and the Terra State No. 1, J.M. Huber Corporation respectively requests an exception to Rule 402. The wells are currently produced with gas cycling equipment and continuous production is important for both mechanical and reservoir reasons.

The test shown on the Form C-125 were taken during a shut-in period in December, 1983 while Llano Inc., (gas purchaser), was exchanging their compressor.
