- 2) Ran tubing and set Baker Lok-Set packer at 13,656'. On and off tool set at 13,654'.
- 3) Perforated 5" OD liner with four .42" shots per foot 13,703-13,707'.
- 4) Flowed Morrow perforations 13,703-13,707', 8 hours 24/64" choke, no water, 12 MCFGPD.
- 5) Set standing valve in Lok-Set packer at 13,654'.
- 6) Loaded tubing with 10# treated brine water. Released on and off tool and pulled tubing.
- 7) Ran tubing and set Baker Lok-Set packer at 13,373'. On and off tool set at 13,371'.
- 8) Perforated 5" OD liner with four .42" shots per foot 13,389-13,403' and 13,411-13,415'.
- 9) Flowed Morrow perforations 13,389-13,403', 13,411-13,415' and 13,703-13,707', 12 hrs., 16/64" choke, 68 bbls. water and 850 MCFGPD.
- 10) Set blanking plug at 13,371'.
- 11) Perforated 5" OD liner with four .42" shots per foot 13,354-13,358' and 13,362-13,366'.
- 12) Flow tested perforations 13,354-13,366' for CAOF 8104 MCFGPD.
- 13) Pulled tubing.
- 14) Ran tubing and set Baker Lok-Set packer at 12,856'.
- 15) Perforated 5" OD liner with one .30" hole at each of the following places: 13,074', 13,086', 13,131', 13,140', 13,199', 13,222', 13,237', 13,258', 13,272', 13,278' and 13,285'.
- 16) Treated perforations 13,074-13,285' with 250 gallons of 15% HF-8CL acid followed with 2000 gallons of 7-1/2% MS acid, using 18 ball sealers, flushed with 72 bbls. of KCL water.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
