
We respectfully request your waiver of objections to our proposal to dually complete, in a conventional tubing/casing manner, our Tidwell-A "COM" Well No. 1 in the South Carlsbad (Morrow) Gas and South Carlsbad (Atoka) Gas Fields. Administrative action by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission will be requested since a prior similar dual completion has been approved by Order No. R-3702 for Pennzoil Company's Mobil "12" Federal No. 1.

The Tidwell-A "COM" No. 1 is located in Unit E, 2310' FN and 660' FW lines, Section 8, T-23-S, R-27-E, Eddy County, New Mexico. Dual completion will be in the Morrow gas zone through perforations 11,412-824', and the Atoka gas zone through perforations 10,748-760'. Morrow production will be through 2-7/8" tubing set in a Baker Model F-1 packer at 11,300'. Atoka production will be through the casing/tubing annulus. Five and one-half inch production casing is set at 11,984' and cemented, with top of cement at 9250'. Other completion data are detailed on the attached Form C-107 "Application for Multiple Completion" and diagrammatic sketch of the proposed multiple completion.

If you have no objections to this proposal, your waiver directed to the Santa Fe office of the Commission, a copy to their Artesia office, and a copy to the writer will be appreciated.
