ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Texas International Petroleum Incorporated made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on February 12, 1973, for permission to dually complete its Tidwell A "Com" Well No. 1 located in Unit E of Section 8, Township 23 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Atoka formation adjacent to the South Carlsbad-Atoka Gas Pool and the Morrow formation adjacent to the South Carlsbad-Morrow Gas Pool.

Now, on this 4th day of March, 1973, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Texas International Petroleum Incorporated, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Tidwell A "Com" Well No. 1 located in Unit E of Section 8, Township 23 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Atoka formation adjacent to the South Carlsbad-Atoka Gas Pool and the Morrow formation adjacent to the South Carlsbad-Morrow Gas Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Shut-In Pressure Test Period for the South Carlsbad-Morrow Gas Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
