

DEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE TURKEY CREEK
SECTION 34, TRACTS, R.D. 2
Sandoval County, New Mexico

- 1. Roads in the area consist of a maintained road leading north from the section house about 7 1/2 miles and a dirt road, which will need repair, leading south for about 1 mile to a point about 130' south of the section house.
- 2. The only necessary access road will be 150'-300' of grading over hilly, extremely uneven terrain. Down cuts and fills will probably require earthmoving.
- 3. Site plan and topographic map will be prepared by John G. Gandy, S.A. (Surveyor) and will be submitted to the Bureau of Land Management.
- 4. N/A
- 5. Land suitable for mining will be located along the main road (N.W. 1/4 of Section 34) and secondary roads or water courses in location by truck.
- 6. Dikes and ditches constructed will be 10' wide at the top, 6' wide at the bottom, 1' deep, and 1' high above ground level.
- 7. A right-of-way will be obtained for the roads.
- 8. Land suitable for grazing will be located along the main road (N.W. 1/4 of Section 34) and secondary roads or water courses in location by truck.
- 9. Land suitable for agriculture will be located along the main road (N.W. 1/4 of Section 34) and secondary roads or water courses in location by truck.
- 10. Land suitable for timber will be located along the main road (N.W. 1/4 of Section 34) and secondary roads or water courses in location by truck.

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
