Dear Sirs:

Your application for a permit to drill a well in Section 10, Township 23 South, Range 26 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, has been received.

The information supplied by you indicates that you intend to drill this well at a location 1980 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line of the above described section. This proposed well location is within the area zoned by the City of Carlsbad's airport zoning ordinance number 732. You also indicate that the elevation of your location is 3304 feet above sea level and that your drilling rig will be 131 feet tall.

We note that on August 16, 1973, the Federal Aviation Administration acting through Earl L. Stone, Jr., Chief, Airspace and Procedures Branch, Southwest Region approved the above described location as an acceptable location.

The planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Carlsbad notes that the horizontal surface above the airport will not be intersected or penetrated by your drilling rig placed at the location approved by the FAA and described above.

This letter therefore constitutes a permit to you to drill a well at a location 1980 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the East line of Section 10, Township 23 South, Range 26 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.
