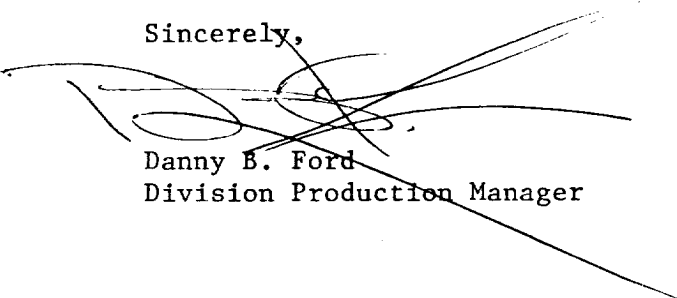
Reference is made to the October 1983, Southeast Gas Proration Schedule (see attachment) concerning the above referenced well. The well was reclassified from marginal to nonmarginal, effective August 1, 1983. When the well produced 15,956 MCF (five times) more than its assigned allowable in August, the computer picked up 36,513 in error causing the well to be flagged and consequently, to be given a shut-in order.

Harold Garcia (505/827-5813), with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division in Santa Fe, informed us that the asterisk was included on the proration schedule in error. Because the Saik did not produce over six times its allowable, the well does not require shut-in.

The well will remain producing at a rate required to obtain its allowable.
