Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated April 26, 1974, requesting a tubing exception for your James E Well No. 1, located in Unit G, Section 11, Township 22 South, Range 30 East, Cabin Lake Field, Eddy County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this well is equipped with a 5 1/2-inch liner, which prohibits running the Strawn tubing below 11,057 feet.

Pursuant to the authority granted me by Commission Rule 107(d)4, Phillips Petroleum Company is hereby granted an exception to Commission Rule 107(d)3 and is authorized to set the Strawn tubing in the subject well at a depth of 11,002 feet.

Should production problems or other difficulties arise from this exception, which indicate that waste or reservoir damage is occurring, this authority may be rescinded.
