Gentlemen:

We are enclosing three maps: (1) showing existing roads, planned access roads, location of wells, and location of tank battery, (2) showing location of rig layout, mud tanks, reserve pits, well pad, and roads, (3) showing sketch of BOP stack and choke manifold.

The water supply and all brine for subject well will be hauled from Malaga, New Mexico.

All waste will be disposed of in the proper manner. All paper, mud sacks, and all other waste of this nature will be either hauled off or disposed of on the location. All metal, rubber, and other waste that needs to be hauled off will be.

The procedure for restoration of the surface is to break out all pits and restore all but the immediate well pad and tank battery pad, if a battery is required, to the natural contour of the land.
