Exhibit "A" Attached is a copy of part of a USGS topographic map showing the area and roads around the proposed location. The plat also shows the nearest drilling activity in Section 3,

Exhibit "B" Attached is a plat of location "C" in Section 1. This plat shows the new road to be built into the location and the caliche pad that will be built on the location. This plat also shows the rig layout including the mud pits, reserve pit, burn pit, water tanks, etc. Note the proposed tank battery site on the southeast corner of the pad. This site will be used if the well finds commercial production.

Water used for the drilling operations will be trucked in.

Disposal of waste material from the drilling operation will be accomplished by burying or by trucking to a sanitary landfill.

When the well is abandoned and after the pits have dried up, the location will be cleaned and leveled. If the well is commercial and is completed as such, the drilling pits will be closed and leveled when they dry out enough.

This location falls in a low area. The surface has sparse vegetation and the soil is apparently unconsolidated Gyp. which would be very slick when wet. Therefore, it will be necessary to build the caliche pad and road into the location.
