Jake L. Hamon is the operator of the above referenced well and also operates the State L 4325 gas well which is a south offset to the referenced well. El Paso takes the gas from both of these wells and is now setting a compressor on the State L 4325 location which is located in the center of NE SW of Section 2, T-24-S, R-26-E.

El Paso will move the sales gas meter from the referenced well to the compressor location at the State L 4325. The gas from both wells will continue to be metered separately. No change will be made with the tank batteries. The sales gas meter will be re-located during the first week in May.

This change is being made so that the gas from both wells can be compressed with one compressor.
