It is proposed to drill a 12 1/4" hole to 600'. Run 8 5/8" casing & cement w/sufficient quantity of cement to circulate to surface. After WOC 18 hrs. and installation of double ram BOP, a 7 7/8" hole will be drilled to approximately 2000'. A low water loss fresh water mud system will be used to drill thru the Delaware formation. Abnormal pressures are not anticipated, therefore mud weight will be maintained at minimum level.

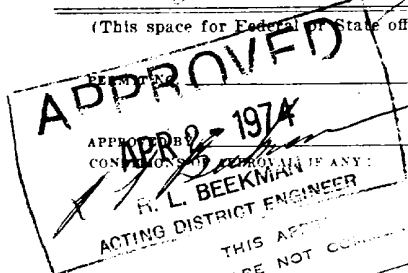

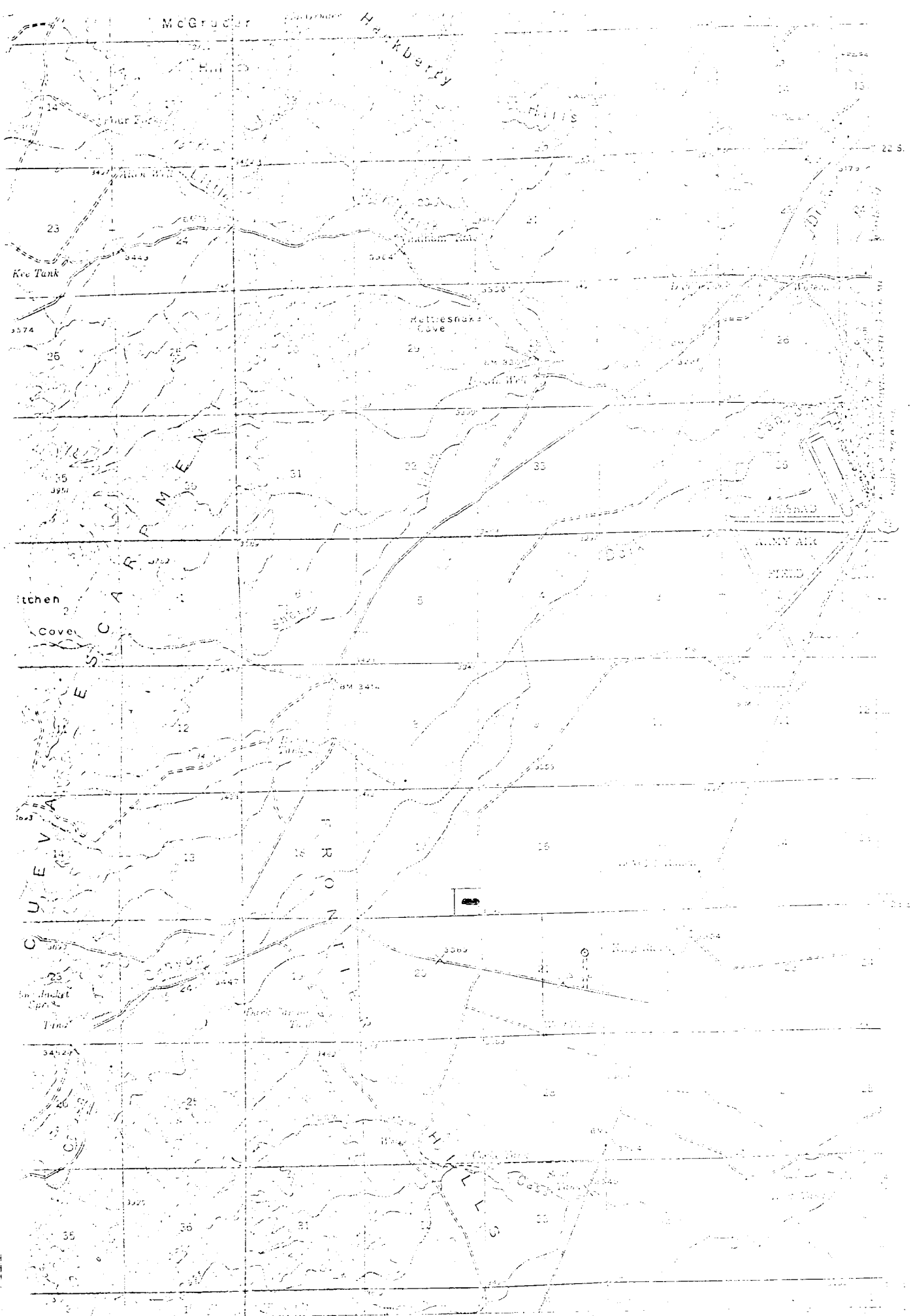

2. U.S.G.S. Topographic Map shows planned access road. Road will be approximately 300' long and 20' wide. (Exhibit 2)
3. Section of the County Ownership Map, Exhibit 3, shows all wells in the vicinity of the proposed location.
4. No lateral roads located within one mile of location.
5. Tank battery and flow line, if needed, will be located on drilling pad.

12. The terrain is flat, dry, grazing land.

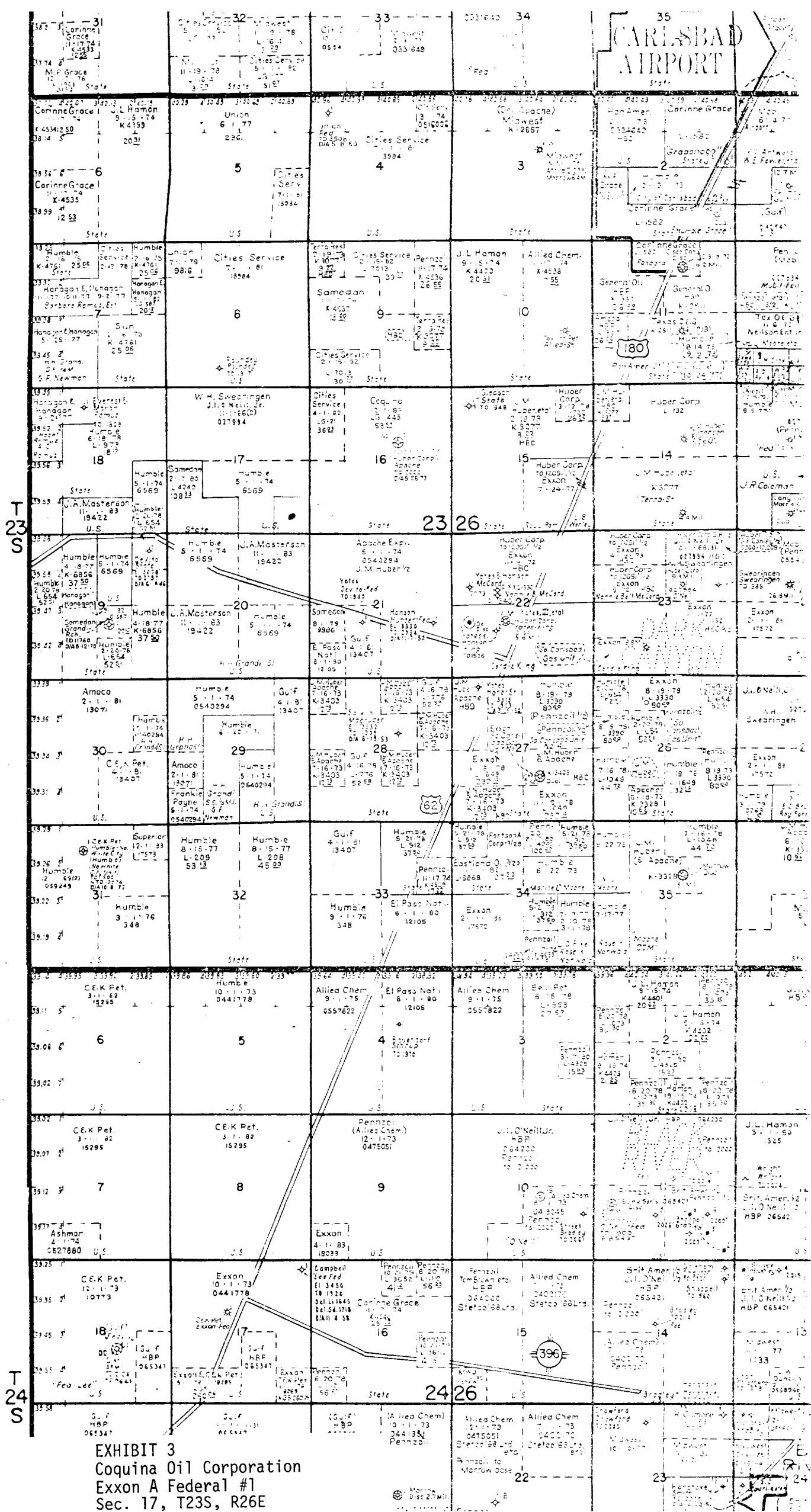

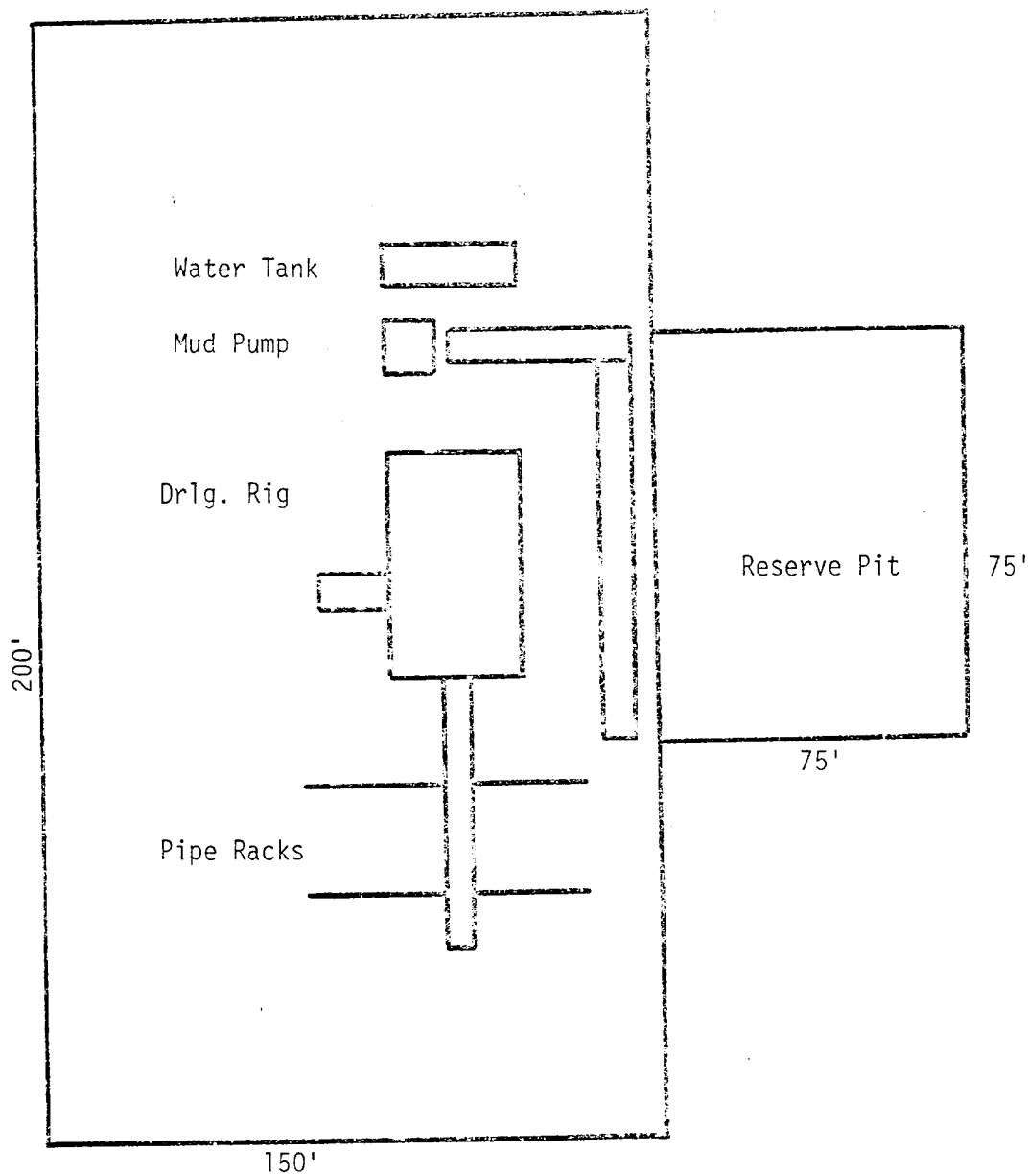
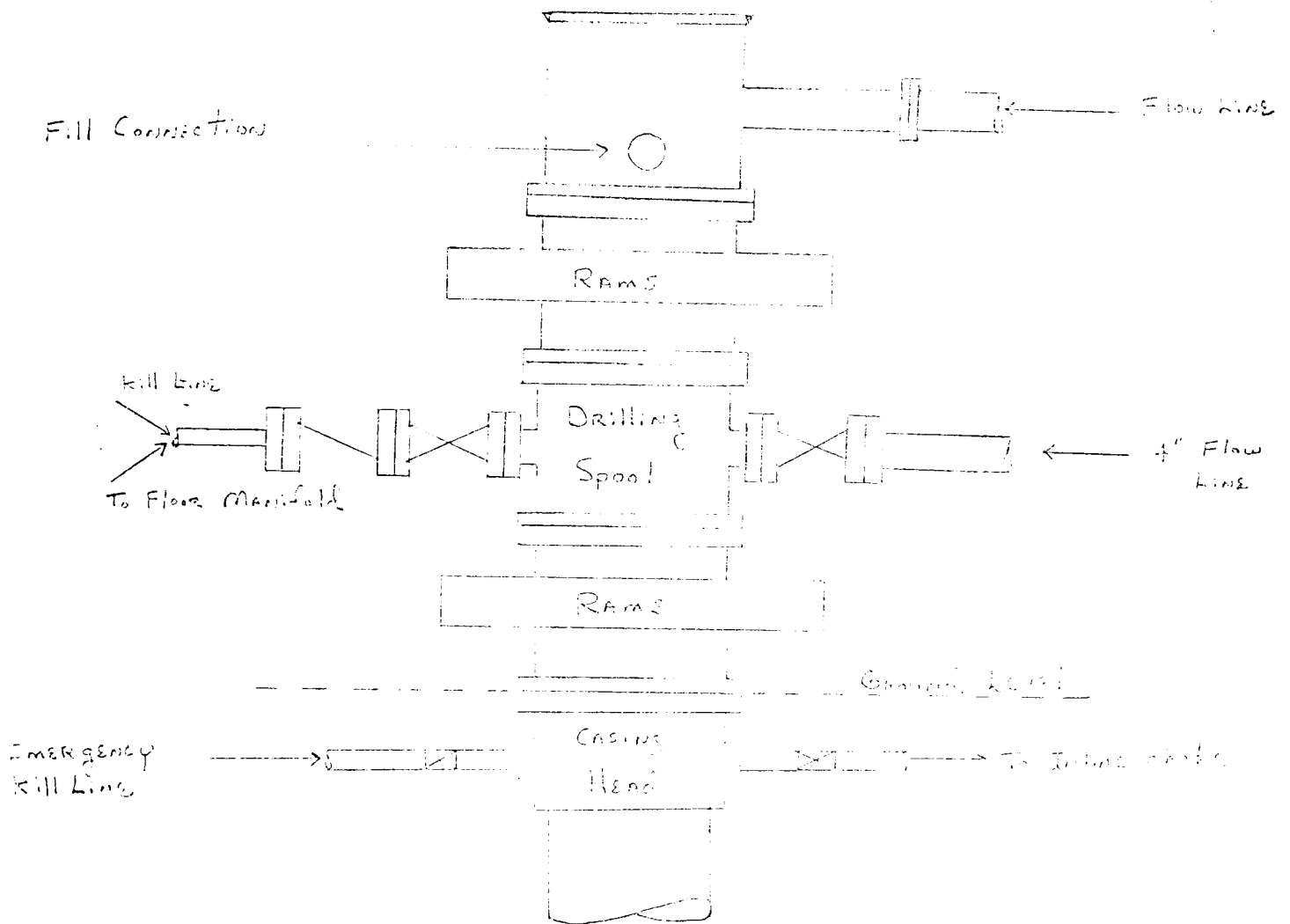
