Reference is made to the Cooperative Agreement, Contract No. EW-70A-04-4185 authorizing the Department of Energy (DOE) to conduct exploration and study activities relating to DOE's proposed Waste-Isolation Pilot Plant Project (WIFP) in Eddy County. New Mexico.

This letter requests your approval to use the abandoned well called "Cabin daby Federal' No. 1, drilled pursuant to lease No. 0545110 issued to Michael P. Grace. The well is located in Eddy County. Section 5, T235, R31E and the location is further described as 1985 FdL and 1980FEL. DGL's proposed use of this well is to acquire by drologic data from geologic formations below the Castile. The well penetrates through the castile, into the Delaware Sands and bottows at a depth of 4150 feet.

For the mast 13 months 00° has written, called and tried to contact Mr. Michael Grace for the empose of obtaining, this well, but Mr. Grace has not responded to our letters or phone calls. If 00° authorizes DOE to use this abandoned well, DOC agrees to assume and bear all the expense with respect to plugging the well and to the restoration of the surface, all in accordance with bLM's prevailing regulations. If the WIPF site is finalized in its present location, we would plug this well with more care than is normally taken since the well is right on the control zone boundary.

We assume that the archeological survey for this location was performed by Mr. Grace, and since the area has already been disturbed and we are requesting use of existing facilities, we are not makin. A special archeological study. For your convenience, we are enclosing a copy of the "Log" for Gabin Laby Federal No. 1.
