Gentlemen:

Enclosed are six approved copies of communitization agreement No. Com. Agr.-561 involving 564.68 acres of land in Federal Leases New Mexico 05070, 05070-A, 0-05053, 010-952-A, NM 19178, and 33.77 acres of unleased Federal land, Pecos County, New Mexico.

The agreement communitizes all rights as to dry gas and associated liquid hydrocarbons producible from the Morrow formation in all of sec. 18, T. 25 S., R. 25 E., N.M.P.M., and is effective as of December 6, 1974. It being understood that lots 12 and 13 of sec. 18 are unleased Federal land, and that proceeds attributable to such lands are to be held in abeyance until such lands are leased.
