

Belco respectfully requests permission to delay running a four-point potential test on the subject well until we obtain a sales line hookup. As you know, the well is close to the city of Carlsbad; therefore, the testing of the well would possibly cause an odor of gas in the vicinity of the well and the venting of the gas would be noisy since we anticipate a large volume on the test.
