
Your request of April 28, 1976, for a six month extension of time in which to commence your second test well under the terms of the Robinia Draw unit agreement, Eddy County, New Mexico, is hereby approved. Accordingly, in the absence of a determination acceptable to this office that the Robinia Draw unit well No. 1 in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 7, T. 23 S., R. 24 E., N.M.P.M. is capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities, the second unit test well is now considered due to be commenced before midnight October 31, 1976.
