- e. Surface Use Grazing
- f. Effect on Environment Drillsite, which is in nearly flat semi-arid, desert country, is in a low environmental risk area. The total effect of drilling and producing in this area would be minimal. No known archelogical, historical, or cultural sites exist in the drill or road areas.
- g. Surface Ownership The drillsite and new access road is located on Federal Land.
- h. Open Pits All unattended pits containing mud or other liquids will be fenced.
- i. Well Sign Sign identifying and locating well will be maintained at drillsite commencing with the spudding of the well.
