The casing design criterion was based upon Aminoil's CNB Com. No. 1 in Section 11 and Aminoil's Willow Lake Unit No. 1 well in Section 22. Both of which were successfully completed with the same casing design.

The location was originally staked at 1980' FSL, 1980' FWL, however, due to the proximity of the unlined irrigation canal and drainage into the canal, the proposed location will be 1940' FSL and 1940' FWL. By moving this location 40' south and west and by placing the reserve pits on the south side, it will ensure proper protection of the canal from any contamination from our reserve pits. This variance on the location will be heard before the Commission on October 12th.
