The "TOTCO" surveys on the subject wells, listing all deviation surveys to the last measurement at 11,380', show a relatively straight hole throughout the well. Maximum deviation was  $3 \frac{3}{4}$  degrees at 2600', in that portion of the hole now covered by  $9 \frac{5}{8}$ " casing. Maximum deviation below the  $9 \frac{5}{8}$ " casing shoe is  $2 \frac{1}{2}$  degrees at 7468'.
