
Dear Steve:

In response to your request a couple of weeks ago for us to examine the well location in Section 4, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, for abandonment, we are submitting the following requirements:

1. We will require that the mud in the east pond be squeezed into the successive ponds to the west to minimize the thickness of the mud.
2. We require a covering of dirt and rock caliche over the mud sufficient enough to stabilize the mud to support vehicle passage.
3. We do not want the mud to be squeezed into the brine lake since that brine is solar evaporated and recrystallized into salt and sold to the United Salt Company, and the mud and chemical contained in the mud would contaminate the salt.
4. It would be permissible to leave all the roadways open out to the extremity of the levy which was made by Amoco.
