Due to rig availability, a 90-day extension of our permit to drill the above described well is respectfully requested. It is anticipated that Delta Drilling Company Rig #3 will drill this well. Rig #3 is presently engaged in drilling a well in Lea County, New Mexico and is expected to TD the well within 80 days. Rig #3 will then be moved to the Culebra #5 location.

USGS Artesia District approval period for Applications for Permit to Drill has been extended, from three months to one year effective June 1, 1979. Accordingly, this application is considered valid through May 14, 1980, one year from approval.
