Bass Enterprises is evaluating re-completion possibilities in the Brushy Canyon Formation. Work is expected to start in early to mid 1997 depending on the results of geological mapping and studies currently being conducted in this area.

Based on the successful casing integrity test (no leak off), we request TA status be extended until August 1, 1997 (18 months).
