- 1) Set cement retainer @ $\pm 10,250'$. Squeeze 50 sacks CL "H" below retainer and leave 25 sacks on top.
- 2) Run free point and cut off 7" casing @ $\pm 9500'$. Pull 7" casing.
- 3) Spot 35 sacks cement plug from $\pm 9550' - 9450'$.
- 4) Spot 50 sacks cement plug from $\pm 2700' - 2600'$.
- 5) Spot 50 sacks cement plug from $\pm 430' - 330'$.
- 6) Spot 10 sacks cement plug from $\pm 20' - 5'$.
- 7) Cut off casing 3' below GL & weld on steel plate.
- 8) Install dry hole marker and restore location.
