Cultural Resources

No archaeological sites or isolated manifestations were recorded during this reconnaissance. Locally, their overall absence is due to a lack of lithic inclusions in associated beds, the high porosity of attendant soils, a bona fide shortage of cover, and remoteness from localities providing man with these resources and amenities. Locally, principal usage of this landform during prehistoric times was toward the northnorthwest within the bounds of Los Medanos.

Recommendations

NMAS recommends clearance for COQUINA OIL CORPORATION'S proposed Pure Gold "A" Federal Well No. 1 and its access road and <u>suggests</u> that work-related activities proceed in accordance with company plans. Clearance, of course, is granted by the Bureau of Land Management.
