## ORDER OF THE DIVISION

## BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on August 17, 1983 at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stamets.

NOW, on this <u>23rd</u> day of August, 1983, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required b law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Amoco Production Company, is the owner and operator of the State "IB" Com Well No. 1, the surface location of which is 660 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line of Section 31, Township 23 South, Kange 25 East, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(3) That the applicant seeks to directionally dill said well by kicking off from the vertical at the approximate casing cutoff point (between 5,000 and 8,000 feet) and drilling directionally to a bottom hole location within 100 feet of a point located 872 feet from the South line and 2,192 feet from the West line of said Section 31.
