Cassidy Com #1 SW NW Section 29-T238-R28E S. Loving (Delaware) Eddy County, New Mexico

PLUG AND ABANDON PROCEDURE:

- 1. MIRUSU, pull rods & pump.
- 2. Kill well, ND tree and NU BOP's.
- 3. Release tubing anchor at 5,787' and TOH with tubing.
- 4. Load hole with 9.0 ppg, 36 VIS (minimum) plug mud.
- 5. RU Wireline and set a 5" 23# CIBP at the top of the Penn. formation at 10,760', cap with 35' of cement.
- 6. The second plug is required at the top of the Wolfcamp formation at 9,317'. This is 67 feet below the top of the 5inch liner, therefore set a 7-5/8" 33.7# CIBP at the liner top at 9,250' and cap with 35 feet of cement, thus plugging the Wolfcamp and the top of the liner.
- 7. Set another 7-5/8" CIBP at 5,920' above the Delaware perfs at 5,938-72' and the DV tool at 5,984'. Cap this plug with 35' of cement.
- 8. Set another 7-5/8" CIBP at 2,460' 50' below the 10-3/4" shoe.
- 9. Work the 7-5/8" casing and cut as deep as possible but it will probably be up inside the 10-3/4" pipe as cement outside the 7-5/8" is up to 2,400'. TOH laying down casing.
- 10. RIH with tubing and pump a 100 foot cement "shoe and stub" on top of the casing stub and CIBP at 2,460'. WOC and tag this plug.
- 11. Pull up to 450 feet and pump a cement plug from 450 feet to surface.
- 12. Set a 10 sack surface plug, cut off 4 feet below ground level and install a cap and dryhole marker with I.D..

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
