Gentlemen:

The surface use and operations plan for the proposed Lentini Federal Com #1 is as follows:

- 1. Existing Roads
 - a. Exhibit "A" is a portion of a general highway map showing location of the proposed well as staked. Go north of Loving, New Mexico 1½ miles to Highway 31; turn east 3/8 mile to proposed new road.
 - b. Exhibit "B" is a plat showing all existing roads in red within a one-mile radius of the well site and the planned access road shown in blue.

2. Planned Access Roads

- a. <u>Length and Width</u>: Required new road will be 1900' long and 12 feet wide and constructed of caliche compacted and watered to a depth of six (6) inches. The new road is labeled and color-coded blue on Exhibits "A" and "B".
- b. <u>Turnouts</u>: One turnout 30' wide will need to be constructed 1000' from Highway 31.
- c. Culverts: None required.
- d. Cuts and Fills: None required.
- e. Gates and Cattleguards: One cattleguard needed at the highway.

3. Location of Existing Wells

The nearest producing wells are the Gulf Eddy "GR" State #1 and Eddy "GR" State #2, located approximately 1 mile south of the proposed location.

4. Tank Batteries, Production Facilities and Lease Pipe Lines

Should production be encountered, the tank battery and other required production equipment will be located on the well pad. All production lines will be constructed on the well pad and above ground. Refer to Exhibit "C".
