

1. EXISTING ROADS:

- A. Exhibit "A" is a portion of a road map showing the location of the proposed well as staked. Point "A" on the plat is on US-285, 3.6 miles south of Malaga, New Mexico, where a caliche road goes west. To go to the proposed well site from this point, exit US-285 and go west 0.14 mile to arrive at Amoco's well No. 1 Federal "AI" Com., a gas well. The proposed well site is approximately 0.8 mile west-northwest of this well.
- B. Exhibit "B" is a plat showing existing roads in the vicinity of the proposed well site. Existing roads are color coded.
- C. Any repair to existing roads does not appear necessary at the present time.

2. PLANNED ACCESS ROAD:

- A. Length and Width: The new road will be 16 feet wide and approximately one mile long. The new road is labeled and color coded red on Exhibit "B". The center line of the proposed new road, from the beginning to the well site, has been staked and flagged.
- B. Surfacing Material: Six inches of caliche, watered, compacted, and graded.
- C. Maximum Grade: Two percent.
- D. Turnouts: None required.
- E. Drainage Design: The new road will be crowned with drainage to both sides.
- F. Culverts: None required.
- G. Cuts and Fills: A minor cut and fill will be required at a point about 300 feet south of the proposed well.
- H. Gates and Cattle Guards: A cattle guard will be installed where the proposed road will cross the north-south fence south of the well site.

3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS:

- A. Existing wells in the immediate area are shown on Exhibit "B".
