Gentlemen:

In regards to your letter of August 22, 1986, requesting administrative approval for hardship status on the above captioned well, some additional information is required.

Please fill out the attached form and satisfy the requirements of each paragraph, ie; well bore, sketch, map or plat, etc. Paragraph 5 makes reference to the minimum sustainable producing rate of a well. In view of the large volume of gas requested daily for hardship status, a log off test will be required on this well. This log off test shall be witnessed by the Division personnel. To set up a test schedule, please contact Mr. Mike Williams of this office for dates and time.

It has been the policy of the Division not to grant hardship status of wells administratively. Therefore, when all required data has been submitted, this matter will be set for a hearing.
