Dear Mr. Stamets:

Reference is made to your letter dated August 26, 1986 requesting an explanation of Llano Inc.'s continued takes from an overproduced well. Llano is taking the gas from this well because Santa Fe asked us not to shut-in the well except as a last resort and also because our markets need the gas.

We were forced to have Santa Fe shut-in this well in February and again in March of this year due to market down time which consequently killed the well. We later assured Santa Fe that we would be able to take the gas if their workover was successful. Consequently we have taken the gas from this well continuously since Santa Fe's May 1986 workover and we plan to continue taking this gas due to high market demand.
