13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operation (clearly state all pertinent details, including estimated starting date of any proposed work and approximate duration thereof. Operator wishes to install a single compressor on the State K 3328 #1 well located in Sec. 36C, Township 23S, Range 26E, Eddy Co., NM. to compress the gas from the State K 3328 #1 and the Mobil Federal #1, and Forehand Federal 25 COM #1 wells, both located in Sec 25F, Township 23S, Range 26E, Eddy Co., NM. The economies of scale will result in extending the economic life of all these wells.

A discharge sales meter will be installed downstream of the compressor and gas sales will be allocated back to each of the three wells based on individual flow percentages. The flow percentage will be calculated by dividing the individual well's metered volume (numerator) by the sum of the three well's metered volume (denominator). This procedure is done for each well to determine its flow percentage. The sales volume is then allocated back to each well by multiplying the well's flow percentage by the metered sales volume. This procedure follows standard oilfield practice.

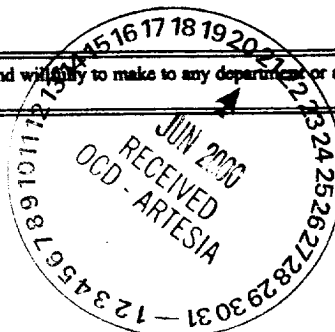
