

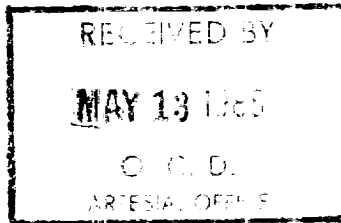

On February 6, 1985 a paid up oil and gas lease was concluded between the undersigned (owners of an undivided $\frac{1}{2}$ of mineral rights of the above described property), and Mr. W. Wayne Gill, P.O. Box 3729, Midland, Texas 79702. The lease provided for a 32% royalty on all production.


The enclosed photocopy of New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission's Well Location And Acreage Dedication Plat (form C-102), filed by Mike Burton, Sr. Drilling Engineer of Santa Fe Energy fails to list myself and my wife as royalty holders and our royalty percentage.


We note that Henry Grandi et ux., owners of the other $\frac{1}{2}$ of the undivided minerals of the described property are listed, as well as Ed Phillips et ux., as overriding royalty interest holders.

In a telephone conversation yesterday with Director, R.L. Stamets, he suggested I contact you about this matter. Under item 2 of form C-102 (copy enclosed) all leases dedicated to the gas well which is currently being drilled are required to be identified as to ownership (both as to working interest and royalty).
