SURFACE USE AND OPERATION PLAN

Bettis, Boyle & Stovall Poker Lake Unit No. 71 660' FNL & 1980' FWL Sec. 33, T23S, R30E Eddy County, N.M.

- 1. Location of Proposed Well:
 - A. Exhibit 'A' is a portion of a map displaying the location as staked. Proposed location is approximately 10 1/2 air miles east of Malaga, New Mexico.
- 2. Access Roads to be Constructed and Reconstructed:
 - A. The new access road will measure 15' wide by approximately 3,700' in length and will enter the southwest corner of the well pad as displayed on Exhibit 'B'.
 - B. As much as 2.1 miles of existing access road will be upgraded by watering, blading and compacting where necessary. Exhibit 'B' displays these roads.
 - C. One cattleguard will be installed in a fenceline. Exhibit 'B' displays the location of the cattleguard.
- 3. Location of Existing Wells:
 - A. Exhibit 'A' also displays the existing wells in the immediate area.
- 4. Location of Proposed Production Facilities:
 - A. Necessary production equipment to produce the well will be constructed on the well pad.
- 5. Location and Type of Water Supply:
 - A. Water necessary for drilling operations will be purchased from a nearby commercial source and trucked to the drill site.
- 6. Construction Materials:
 - A. Construction materials will be caliche and will be purchased from a Federal pit located in the NE/4 of NE/4, Sec. 5, T24S, R30E. An archaeological survey conducted on pit by NMAS, Carlsbad, July 13, 1988, submitted under report #NMAS-1988-06-JY.
