

ENRON OIL & GAS COMPANY  
MULTI-POINT SURFACE USE AND OPERATIONS PLAN

Federal 24 Com., Well No. 1  
710' FNL & 2210' FWL  
Section 24, T24S, R28E  
Eddy County, New Mexico

This plan is submitted with the Application for Permit to Drill the above-described well. The purpose of the plan is to describe the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations, the magnitude of necessary surface disturbance involved and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operation so that a complete appraisal can be made of the environmental effects associated with the operation

1. EXISTING ROADS:

Exhibit "A" depicts the location of the proposed well as staked. New Mexico County road 114 runs East and West approximately 1200' North of proposed well.

PLANNED ACCESS ROADS:

Proposed road measures approximately 900' in length and 20' in width. New road required will be from Dinero Operating's Dewey #2 located 560' FNL & 2060' FEL, Section 24, T24S, R28E.

New road required will be surfaced with six inches of caliche water compacted and graded. It will have a maximum grade of 3 percent with no turnouts required.

The upgraded road will have a drop of 6 inches from the center line on each side for drainage with no culverts, cuts and fills nor gates and cattleguards.

3. LOCATION OF EXISTING WELLS:

Existing wells in the surrounding area include Dinero's Dewey #2 located 1010 feet to the east, and Enron's Queen Lake 19 Federal #1 located approximately 6370 feet to the east in Section 19, 24S, 29E.
