

- D. Ponds & Streams: Yellow Jacket Spring is located about six and one-half miles southwest of the staked location.
- E. Residences and other Structures: The wellsite is located in the Cavern City Airport property and is 750' perpendicular to one of the runways. There are producing wells located to the east, west and north.
- F. Land Use: The Cavern City Airport currently uses the property. Permitting is being filed conjunctively with the Federal Aviation Administration, City of Carlsbad and the Bureau of Land Management. (See attached permits)
- G. Surface Owner: The wellsite is located on the Cavern City Airport property and is owned by the City of Carlsbad.
- H. Archaeology: As the Cavern City Airport has been built on the property and the wellsite falls within the fenced area, no archaeological survey has been performed. However, if one should be deemed necessary, a survey will be initiated at a later date.
