Gentlemen:

On May 2, 1993, we completed a field examination of the abandoned Donnell 3 Fed. No. 1 well located 1980 feet FNL and 1980 feet FSL in Section 3, T. 22 S., R. 30 E., Eddy County, New Mexico.

The following actions must be completed prior to abandonment approval.

- The surface location is to be cleaned and leveled per Bureau of Land Management (BLM) requirements.
- The drill pad and 0.6 miles of access road should be ripped to a minimum of 12" depth.
- The drill site (including reserve pit area) and 0.6 miles of access road are to be reseeded according to the attached specifications for Seed Mixture No. 4.
- All ripped surfaces are to be protected from vehicular travel by constructing a dead-end ditch and earthen barricade at the entrance to these ripped areas. The barricade is to be constructed using spoil material from the ditch and should be of sufficient size to discourage vehicle entry.
- Special Stipulations: Remove the two storage tanks, separator, flowline, pipe, tubing, well head, and well sign. Recontour the pad by pushing the pad fill from the south and southeast to the northwest.
