This plan is submitted with Form 3160-3, Application for Permit to Drill, covering the referenced well. The plan describes the location of the proposed well, the proposed construction activities and operations plan, the magnitude of necessary surface disturbance, and the procedures to be followed in rehabilitating the surface after completion of the operation so that complete appraisal can be made concerning the environmental effects associated with the operations.

1. Existing Roads

- A. Exhibit -A- is a topographic map showing the location of the proposed well as staked with existing roads and conditions within the one mile area. The proposed location is approximately 7 miles northeast from Whites City, New Mexico as shown on Exhibit -B-.
- B. From Whites City, take Highway 62/180 northeast for 4-4.2 miles to an existing lease road. Turn right and go east .5 mile then south on new road .4 mile to well pad.

2. Access Road

- A. Our proposed access road will be an estimated 1250 feet southeast from State Highway 62/180 as shown on Exhibit -C-.
- B. The access road is an existing lease road 1900 feet east, which will be improved and repaired as required and includes a cattle guard where it comes off the highway. We will extend the existing road south 1350 feet to our location. All of the access road will be on BTA's lease as shown on Exhibits -A- and -C-.
- C. The access road will be crowned for drainage with ditching on both sides of the roadway and turnout ditches located every 400 feet. All roads will be maintained during drilling operations and, if productive, as long as producing.

3. Location of Existing Wells

- A. All existing wells within a one mile radius of our proposed well are shown on Exhibit -E-.
