In compliance with BLM NTL-2B, it is proposed to dispose produced Delaware brine from this well into an approved disposal well. The disposal well is Bird Creek Resources' E. Loving SWD No. 1, located in NE/NE/4, Section 15, T23S R28E, Eddy County, New Mexico. That SWD well currently operates under NMOCD Order No. R-9509, dated 5-22-92. Primary means of disposal will be via a 3" poly pipeline (buried) which has recently been installed from Hallwood Fed. No. 1 to the SWD No. 1. The pipeline will operate at 75# psig. Should pipeline problems ever occur, the alternate means of disposal would be via truck transport off-lease to SWD No. 1. A copy of the NMOCD Order for SWD No. 1 is attached for your file.

A sample water analysis, from a nearby well completed in the same zone, is attached. The subject well currently makes 60 BWPd.

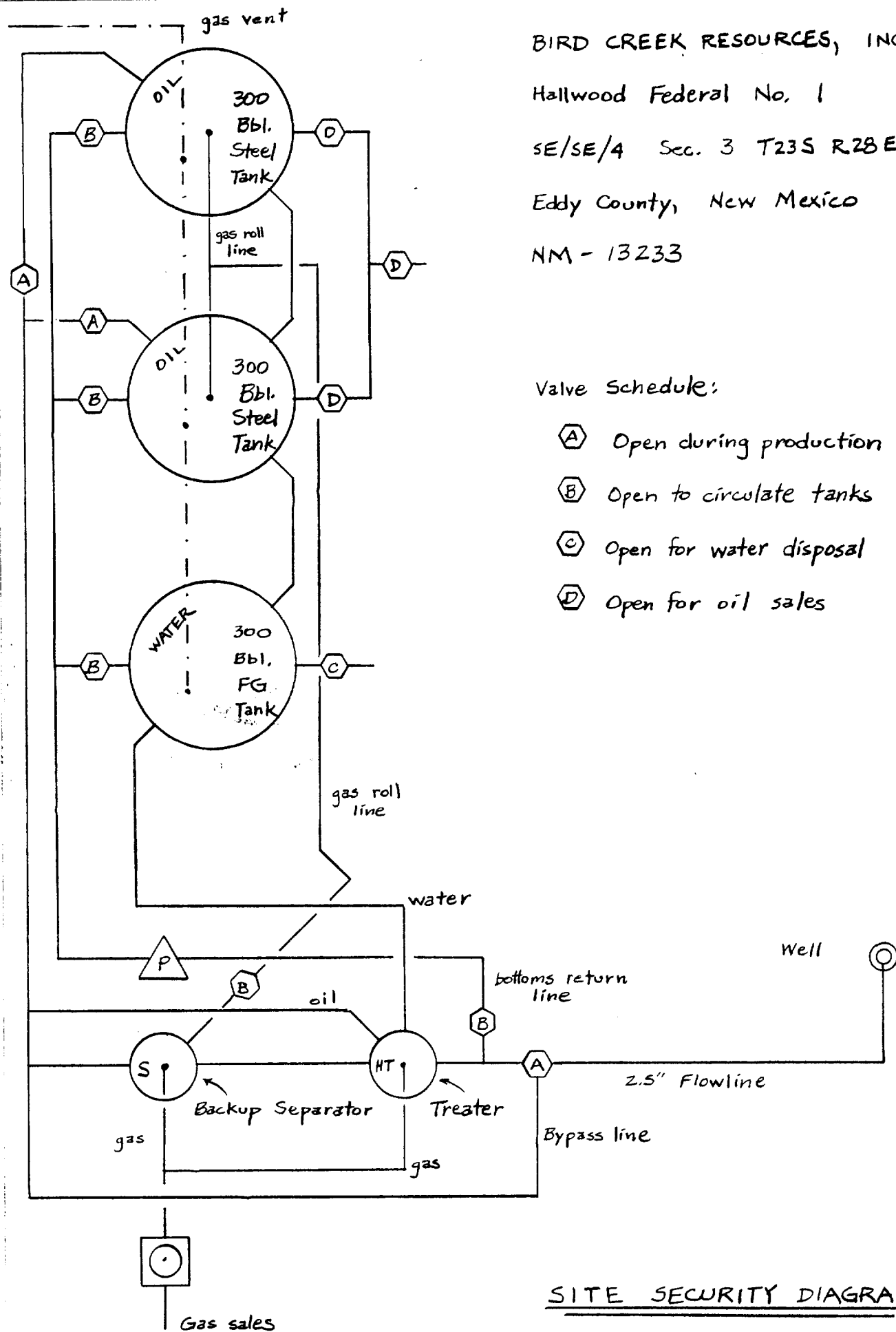
