On 8-1-93, we perforated the Lower Brushy Canyon "D" zone from 8078'-8104' with a 4" casing gun (1 sp2f, 14 total holes). On 8-3-93, we acidized the new perfs with 1000 gals of 7 1/2% NEFE acid + 25 ball sealers. The perfs were fraced on 8-5-93, with 34,450 gals gelled 2% KCl water + 76,000 lbs 16/30 Ottawa sand and 24,000 lbs 16/30 resin coated sand. The well was opened to the pit immediately following the frac for forced closure. Currently, we are preparing to stimulate additional Lower Brushy Canyon pay.
