Cmtd w/310 sx Gas Bloc Class "H" + 2% B-28 + 0.1% D153 + 2 gps D-600 + 0.1 gps D-604AM + 0.25% D-800 + 0.05 gps M-45 (15.8 ppg, 1.21 ft³/sx). PD @ 0959 hrs MDT 5/24/93. Disp w/drilling mud. Cmt w/600 sx 50/50 Poz "H" + 2% D-20 + 6% D-44 + 0.4% D112 + 0.2% D-46 (13.8 ppg, 1.49 ft³/sx) and 775 sx 50/50 Poz "H" (addit as above) (14.2 ppg, 1.36 ft³/sx) and 225 sx Class "H" + 2 gps D600 + 0.2% D604AM + 0.05 gps M-45 + 2% B28 (16.4 ppg, 1.09 ft³/sx). 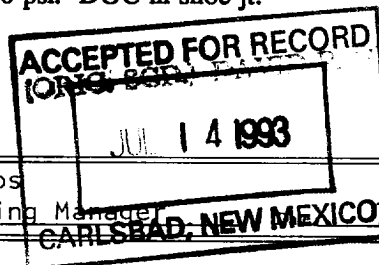
