1. **ABSTRACT:** intensive archaeological survey of the Mitchell Energy Corporation Fasline R/W to the Apache 25 Federal Well No. 2; a pipeline R/W (ca. 3200 ft. long x 100 ft. wide), with a total federal land surface of ca. 7.35 acres, was inspected for cultural remains. Some 1250 ft. of the pipeline R/W is immediately adjacent to the extant caliche road on the south side of the railroad to the WIPP site.

An archaeological survey was conducted on July 15, 1993 on the Fasline (Pipeline) R/W to the Apache 25 Fed. Well No. 2, with some 2.0 work hours spent on ground, during the survey.

Archaeological survey of the Mitchell Energy Corporation Fasline R/W to the Apache 25 Federal Well No. 2 did not reveal any cultural resources.

Therefore, archaeological clearance for the Mitchell Energy Corporation Fasline R/W to the Apache 25 Federal Well No. 2 is recommended.
