Install temporary polyethylene water line (fasline) on surface of ground from Apache "25" Federal No. 1 location as shown on attached plat. DOE representative at WIPP site (Dan Robertson) has granted permission to lay water line under WIPP railroad track (thru culvert) and along railway ROW as shown. Water line will be removed as soon as drilling and completion of well is complete (75 days) and no permanent surface damage will result. There is no evidence of any archaeological, historical, or cultural sites along the route shown on plat. A Cultural Resources Examination has been performed by Arch Survey Consultants and has been sent to your office.
