Operation Plan

Quahada Ridge "31" Federal #1

Collins & Ware, Inc. proposes to drill a horizontal hole out of the existing productive Quahada Ridge "31" Federal #1 wellbore to a MD of 7065' or TVD of 6115'.

Below are the proposed operations expected:

- 1. Build location and reserve pits.
- 2. Move in well service unit and equipment.
- 3. Squeeze existing perfs from 6104' to 6310'.
- 4. Cut and mill section in 5 1/2" casing from 6050' to 6100'.
- 5. Spot cement plug and dress off to the kick-off point of 6065'. Run short radius angle hole assembly and drill lateral portion of hole from 6065' to 7065' MD (6115' TVD), 1000', while maintaining a 90° inclination and an azimuth of 0°.
- 6. Horizontal wellbore will be completed open hole.
- 7. Garbage and trash produced will be disposed of into a wire mesh trailer and hauled to an approved disposal site.
- 8. Existing access roads will be maintained to allow easy access throughout drilling operations.
- 9. After drilling operations and completion efforts have ended, the well site area will be cleaned and reserve pits dried and covered per BLM requirements.
