I cannot release a trace of our LMR in section 36. I will, however, indicate those areas in section 36 where Western Ag-Minerals will not protest drilling of holes requiring a 1/4 mile buffer. Hole locations in the NE 1/4, SE 1/4, and 920' or more from the west line in the SW 1/4 will not be protested.

Any well locations in the NW 1/4 will be protested because they will result in further loss of potash reserves.
