

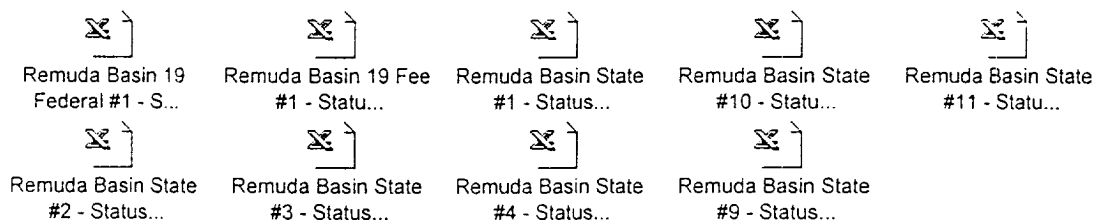

The NMOCD abolished the Forty Niner Ridge Delaware, SW Pool and changed the name of the Nash Draw Brushy Canyon Pool to the Nash Draw Delaware Pool. Wells that were in the abolished Forty Niner Ridge Delaware, SW Pool have been reassigned to the Nash Draw Delaware Pool. This action, described in CASE 12575 of the attached docket, should reduce paperwork complications regarding surface and downhole commingling at Remuda Basin in the future. Please execute the attached status changes so that production from our wells at Remuda Basin is accounted for and reported properly. Thanks!



Ray Short - New Delaware wells at Remuda Basin should be assigned to the Nash Draw Delaware Pool (47545). Please make note of this pool name and number for use on future OPTs and other status changes.
