APPLICATION OF TEXACO EXPLORATION & PRODUCTION, INC. FOR SALT WATER DISPOSAL, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 701(B), Texaco Exploration & Production, Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on October 5, 2000, for permission to **recomplete** for salt water disposal its Remuda Basin '19' Federal Well No.2 (API No. 30-015-28901) located 510 feet from the North line and 1580 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 19, Township 23 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

THE DIVISION DIRECTOR FINDS THAT:

- (1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701(B) of the Division Rules and Regulations;
- (2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators and surface owners have been duly notified;
- (3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 will be met; and
- (4) No objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

The applicant herein, is hereby authorized to complete its Remuda Basin '19' Well No.2 (API No. 30-015-28901) located 510 feet from the North line and 1580 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 19, Township 23 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, in such manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Bell Canyon and Cherry Canyon formations at approximately 3402 feet to 4634 feet through 2 7/8-inch plastic-lined tubing set in a packer located at approximately 3345 feet.
