Under cover letter dated January 14, 1997 you were provided 5 copies of your Form C-101 (Application for Permit to Drill) and Form C-102 (Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat) for the captioned well, together with a Vicinity Map and a Location Verification Map for your convenience.


We plan to test and complete this well within about a week and will hopefully need to transport oil following testing the well as well as secure allowable and transportation authorization once the well is placed on production.

Since the well has not yet been fully completed, I am submitting your Form C-104, partially completed to provide information that is currently available so that we might be able, on short notice, to secure your approval to transport oil produced as a result of the testing of the well.

In case time becomes a factor (tax filings are going to slow the mail down), I'll call you folks and fax a copy of this if needed, but wanted to get it in the mail to start the ball rolling. Please let us know if anything further will be needed at this time. I realize you will need a completed Form C-105 before full approval can be completed.
